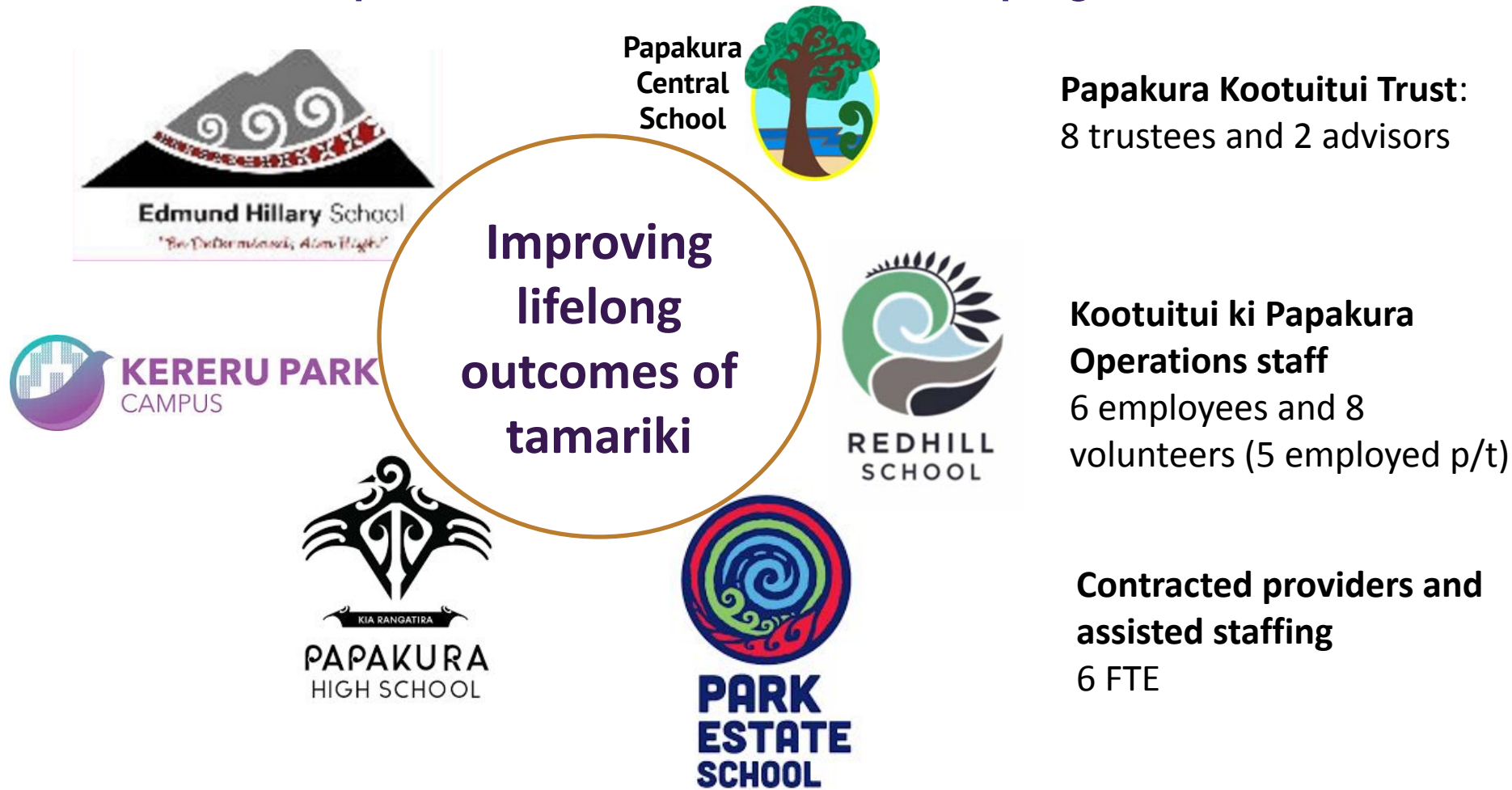

A cluster of 6 Papakura schools: 1820 students: a programme of 3 strands

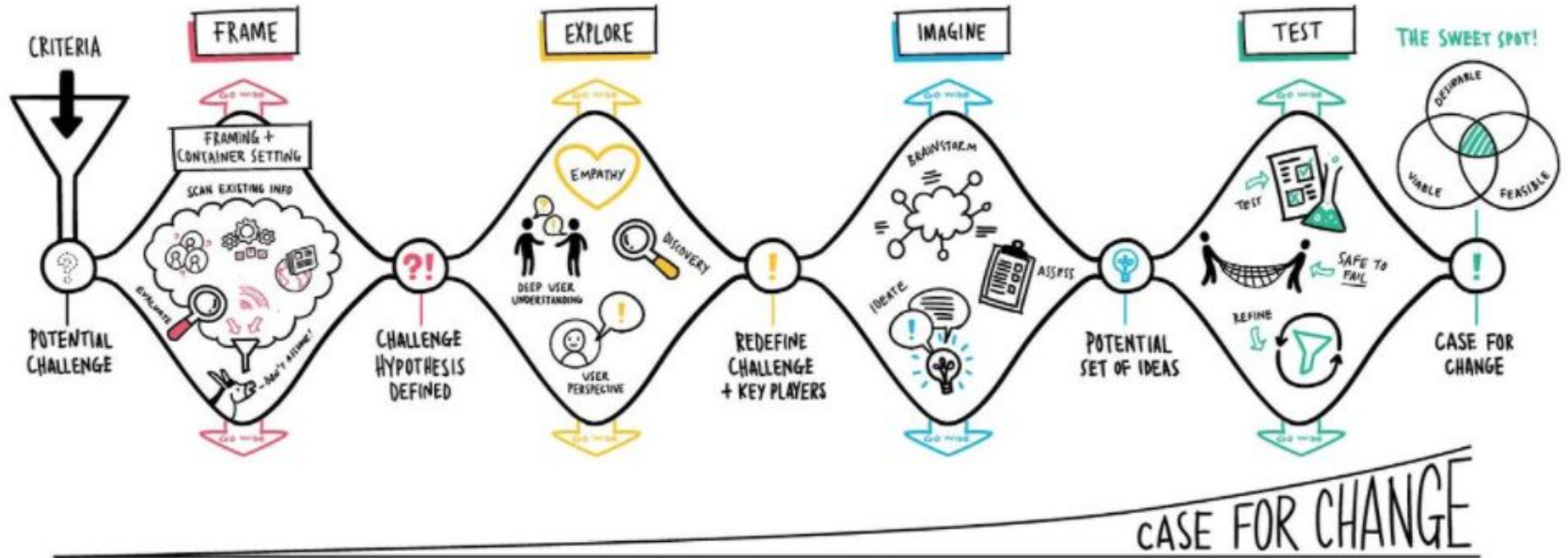
